

### **Guidance for 10.30 Service on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July:**

- Please continue to wear a facemask until seated, when leaving the building and when taking communion (\* medical exemptions apply)
- You are encouraged to use the QR code on entry and there are paper forms in the pews on which you may manually record your attendance at the service (Please leave these on the cross-aisle table at the end of the service)
- Hand sanitizer is available for use upon entry and exit
- The collection plate will remain at the entrances and you are encouraged to make a donation on entry so the collection can then be blessed during the service.
- Hymn books and services sheets are located at the church doors for you to pick up

### **The church is to be divided in to two zones:**

- To the East of the cross-aisle masks are optional during the service (except when taking communion) and congregational singing is allowed
- The West end of the church, back from the cross aisle, is reserved for those who wish to maintain mask wearing throughout the service and here there will be no congregational singing.
- The Stewards will fill the rear zone from the back forwards, and the front zone from the front backwards.
- Seating is marked out to maintain 1 metre social distancing

**The Peace** - will remain socially distanced, with no physical contact

**Hymns** - One hymn will be sung in church and the final hymn will be sung in the churchyard at the end of the service – weather permitting. Cold drinks will be served in the churchyard afterwards

### **Taking Communion**

- There will continue to be no common cup
- The distribution of Communion will be as follows:  
The Front Zone will receive by going up to the nave altar  
The Rear Zone will receive in their seats

### **Other details**

- Cushions have been reinstated and all pews may be used as marked
- ALL 3 doors are to remain open for the duration of the service
- The registration or recording of attendees is no longer required and is thus optional

*These arrangements have been designed by the churchwardens for this Sunday only. They are endorsed by the PCC. Thereafter they will be reviewed by the churchwardens, with an integral risk assessment, on a weekly basis, taking account of pandemic figures and the views of all parties – clergy and congregation. The churchwardens would welcome your feedback after the service.*
